- 3) Front bedroom window and back bedroom window to be egressed. Where a window opening has multiple windows, then all windows in the opening shall match.
- 4) Install new sliding glass door if installed (follow window specs).
- 5) Ensure units are properly fastened and completely sealed around frames per code.
